Theoretical Components

Unit Title	Description
Leadership in Professional Practice	Equips students with skills to lead care delivery.
Nurse as Educator in Practice	Supports learning in practice environments.
Research in Professional Practice	Develops research skills for portfolio development.
Recognising and Responding to Serious Illness	Prepares students to respond effectively to acute and deteriorating conditions.

Proficiency Area	Details
Advanced Clinical Decision-Making and Care Coordination	Demonstrate proficiency in complex care planning and coordination.
Professional Values	Leadership, advocacy, and ethical practice.
Medicines Management	Focus on safety, accountability, and patient education.
Episodes of Care	Reflect complex, multi-disciplinary interventions.
