

Accommodation Support for Nursing & Midwifery Students

We understand that accommodation needs can change throughout the year, especially during placements or summer periods. Here's what support is available and how you can access it:

What's Available?

1. Extended Stay in University Halls

- If you're already living in university halls, you're guaranteed the option to extend your stay over the summer.
- Please note: You may not remain in the same room or hall, but accommodation will be provided.
- The University's **Accommodation Office will contact you in early March** asking you to request extended accommodation over the summer period if necessary. You must complete this request by the specified deadline in order to receive accommodation.

2. Support for Students in Private Accommodation

- If you're in private housing, the first step you should take is to contact your current landlord to enquire if you can extend your contract over the summer. You should do this in January to ensure there is adequate time to find alternative accommodation if necessary.
- If you are unable to extend your current agreement, therefore requiring temporary accommodation, the Accommodation Office and your School Hub team will help you find suitable options with our trusted accommodation partners listed below:

3. Limited Rooms

A small number of rooms in University Halls (approx. 15) may be available for students who cannot extend their private accommodation.

- Priority will be given to those most in need. Applications must be submitted by 17th April.
- These rooms are designed to provide short-term support for students in exceptional circumstances. As spaces are very limited, we encourage you to explore all other options first. If you've done so and still need help, we're here to assist you.
