<b>3</b>	<p><b>Student Representatives' Report</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teaching quality was reported to be a major strength</li> <li>More support with academic writing and assignment literacy would be welcomed (the programme team considered how this could be further embedded within and beyond the programme and also signposted to existing resources, e.g. My Learning Essentials)</li> <li>AI and digital academic skills support could be enhanced</li> <li>The visibility and structure of careers guidance could be improved</li> <li>Students said they would like more opportunities for cohort interaction and social activities</li> <li>A 'monthly check in' by academic advisors on their advisees was also suggested</li> </ul>

<b>4</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teaching, Learning and Assessment Review</li> <li>Dissertation Review 2024/25 - there were generally positive comments from supervisors about their experiences of marking dissertations following the reduction in word length from 15,000 to 12,000. Experiences of marking using Speedgrader/Canvas were mixed: in some respects, it was preferable to BB but there were some issues around navigation and locating supervisee's dissertations, although these issues were addressed to a certain extent once marking groups were set up.</li> <li>Semester 1 Core Units: EDUC70531, EDUC70331, EDUC60011 - CUDs reported that these had gone well and they had received positive feedback from students</li> <li>External Examiner's Report – this was based solely on the Dissertation unit but was very positive overall and the marking team were commended on their marking and feedback. The EE did raise one or two issues, including some small inconsistencies in feedback between markers and suggested that feedforward could be more detailed in some cases.</li> </ul>
