- Personal details
- Course details
- Educational background – Schools/colleges attended
- Qualifications taken
- Qualifications pending
- Personal statement
- Reference

Personal Statement Structure

Question 1: Why do you want to study this course or subject?

Question 2: How have your qualifications and studies helped you to prepare for this course or subject?

Question 3: What else have you done to prepare outside of education, and why are these experiences useful?

Your Reference

- **Communication between you and your referee is crucial**
- **Make sure they are aware of what you do outside the classroom e.g. extra-curricular, involvement in school/college activities, work experience**
- **Teachers like to be positive, but have a duty to you and your university choices to be realistic**

Things to note

- 1 **Research** your application
- 2 **Set yourself** clear and realistic **goals**
- 3 **Meet deadlines** and keep form accurate
- 4 **Be available** on results day
