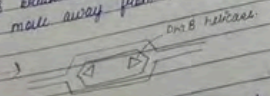




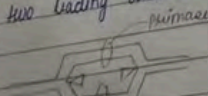


DNA helix winds around these proteins
 three forks the B.P. to break at the OR
 * origin is A-T rich (easier to break)

The prepriming complex
 formed by the attachment of DnaB
 protein to the origin
 DnaB is a helicase
 DnaB breaks more B.P. so replication
 fork move away from the origin.



Primosome formed by attachment of 2
 primase enzymes
 They make the RNA primers that initiate replication
 of the two leading strands.

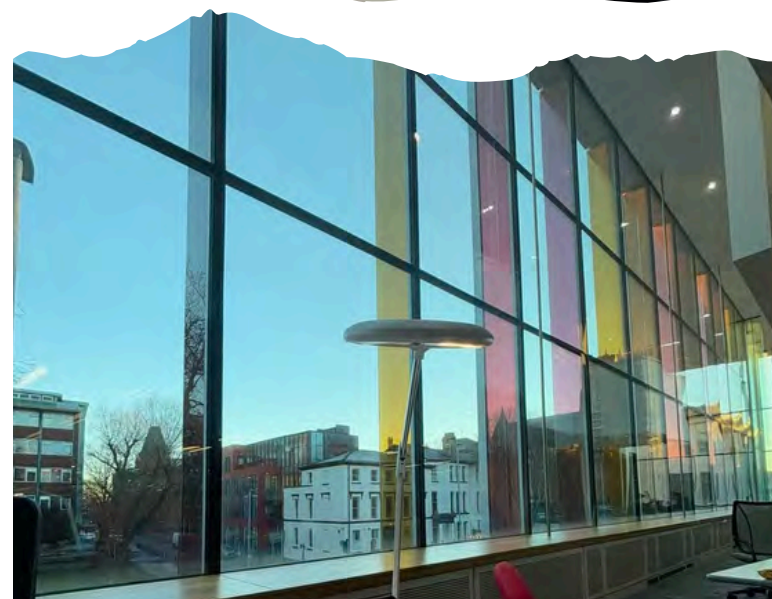
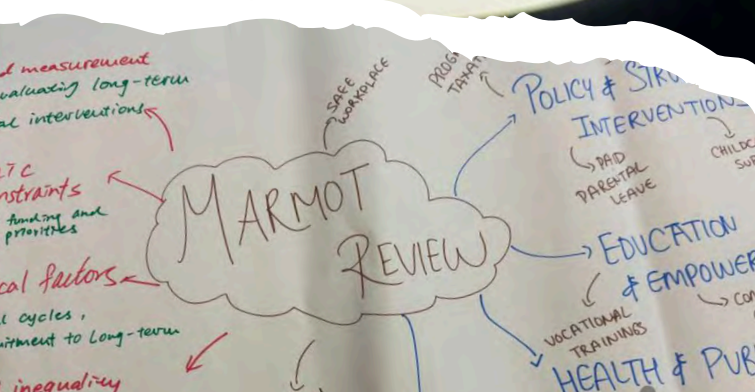
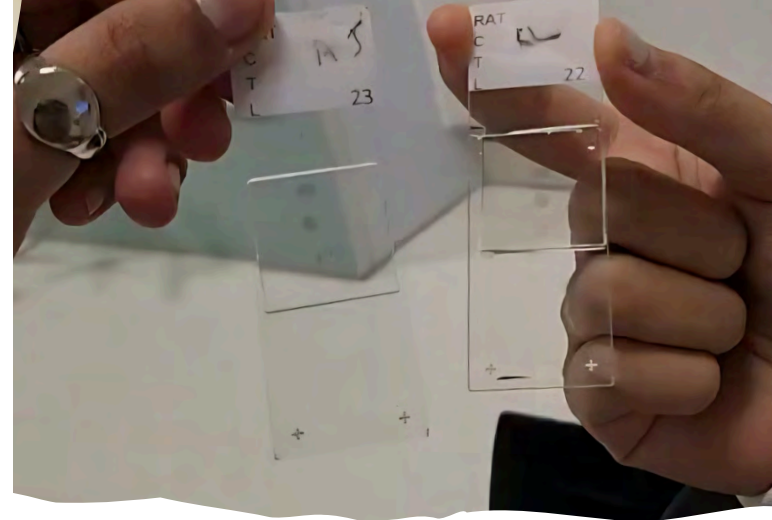
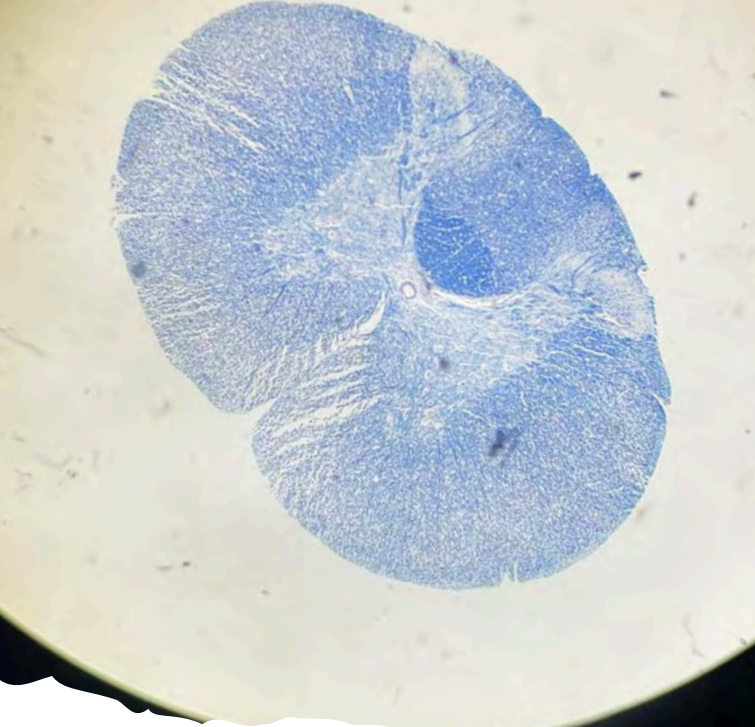

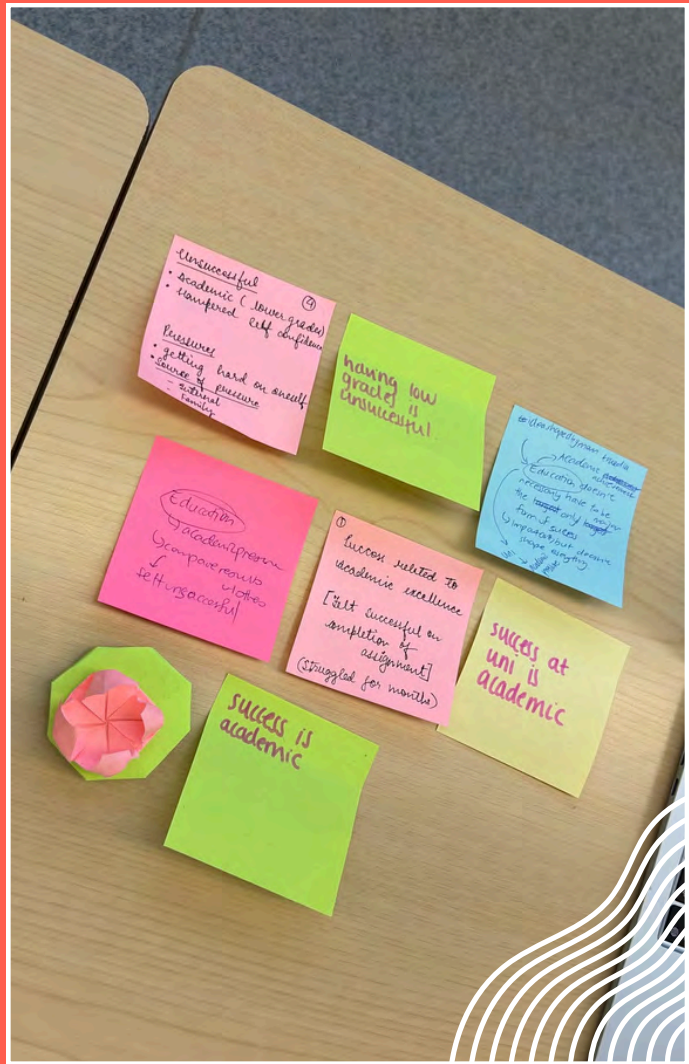
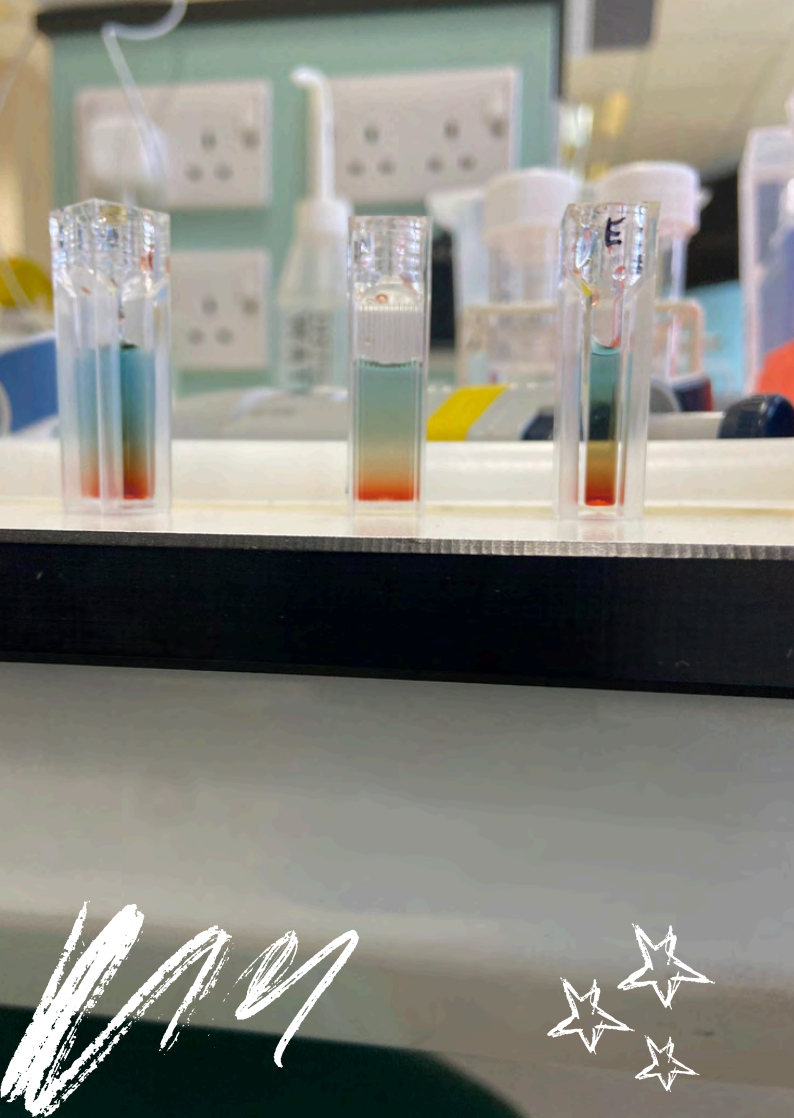
DNA pol delta synthesizing DNA
