

Decision Manchester Frequently Asked Questions

If I am applying for more than one course at UoM, will I submit more than one Decision Manchester form?

No, you will submit **one** Decision Manchester application form (same as UCAS). The same form will be sent to all the Admissions Tutors responsible for the courses that you are applying for.

If you are thinking about applying for different courses, you will need to consider this when writing your personal statement. It is only advisable to apply to more than one course when they are related e.g. *Economics and Economics and Accounting*.

The other example is where you only have 4 choices for a particular course e.g. Medicine and Dentistry. Here it is common for students to use their 5th choice for a related course e.g. Biological Sciences. Please note that not all courses will accept 5th choice applications where your personal statement is geared towards another subject area.

Can I change my mind about the courses I want to apply for when I fill in my actual UCAS form?

Yes, you can change your mind – Decision Manchester is not a final application to the University of Manchester.

However, the benefit of Decision Manchester is that you will know which courses you are going to be made offers for (or invited to the next stage of the application process) at Manchester **before** you send off your UCAS application. If you do change your mind about which course(s) you apply for, please remember that your application may not be successful as you will not have had the opportunity to find out beforehand.

Is the MAP Decision Manchester form or my outcomes seen by other universities?

No, your MAP Decision Manchester form will only be seen by Admissions Tutors at The University of Manchester, and your outcomes will only be shared with you.

Do I need to provide my predicted grades?

No, we will be in contact with your school or college to obtain your predicted grades.

Do I need to write anything on my UCAS application to show that I have completed MAP?

Can I change my personal statement after getting a successful outcome through Decision Manchester?

The outcome of your Decision Manchester application is based on the information you provided in the application form, which includes your personal statement.

Therefore, we cannot guarantee that you would receive the same offer through UCAS as your Decision Manchester outcome if you do change the information provided. We would strongly recommend that you do not make anything but minor changes (e.g. spelling and grammar) to your personal statement before you submit it through UCAS.

Please be assured that if you receive a successful outcome through Decision Manchester, it will be upheld through UCAS.

Can I apply through Decision Manchester next year?

Yes, you will still be eligible for the MAP differential offer and the chance to go through Decision Manchester if you are applying to university next year, for entry in 2028. We recommend emailing map@manchester.ac.uk in June to make sure you are sent all the resources to participate.
