(1) Health & safety management across organisational boundaries(2) Health & safety procedure, 2009/10

Action: HOSs and other senior managers are asked to note:

- new guidance on managing health and safety across organisations boundaries, and to ensure colleagues involved in such situations are made aware of this, and
- updated general procedure for implementing the University's health & safety policy
- (1) A number of managers have requested guidance on the practicalities of managing staff and students who are not co-located with them, or work off site in buildings controlled by others. Typical examples on campus include research staff attached to one school but working in a research institute, or PSS staff working in a unitary but devolved directorate such as finance or HR. Off-campus examples include staff involved in collaborations where some of their work takes place in an industrial or commercial setting.
